

HUD's Homeless Policy Priorities and Program Highlights for CoC's



IVCCC Funding Principles

1.

Invest in programs that support Imperial County's homeless population priorities and align with HUD-recommended subpopulations such as veterans, youth, families and chronically homeless individuals.

2.

Invest in programs that address significant service gaps among the chronically homeless and establish accountable, long-term, and sustainable results.

3.

Invest in programs that support the Housing First policy and emphasize on a comprehensive coordinated service delivery approach to wraparound services to ensure successful housing and self-sufficiency outcomes.

4.

Invest in programs that work towards eradicating homelessness in the region by addressing the underlying causes and lessening the negative impact on individuals, families, and community.

5.

Invest in programs that support Imperial County's service priorities: permanent housing, rapid re-housing, emergency shelters, transitional.

Target Populations

- Homeless under other Federal statues **(not eligible)**

- Fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence dating violence, stalking, human trafficking

Domestic Violence Bonus	\$146,615
CoC Bonus	\$117,292
CoC Planning (Collaborative Applicant Only)	\$50,000

*** Applicants must match grant funds with no less than 25 percent of funds or in-kind contributions from other sources in accordance to 24 CFR 578.73**

Domestic Violence Bonus (\$146,615)

Permanent Housing – Rapid Rehousing

- Projects dedicated to serving survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking that are defined as homeless (24 CFR 578.3).

Joint Transitional Housing/Permanent Housing-Rapid Rehousing

- Component projects dedicated to serving survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking who are defined as homeless (24 CFR 578.3).

Supportive Services Only- Coordinated Entry

- Project to implement policies, procedures, and practices that equip the CoC's coordinated entry to better meet the needs of survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking.



CoC Bonus (\$117,292)

New projects created through the CoC Bonus include:

Permanent Housing – Permanent Supportive Housing	Permanent Housing – Rapid Rehousing	Joint Transitional Housing/Permanent Housing – Rapid Rehousing component	Dedicated Homeless Management Information System	Supportive Services Only – Coordinated Entry
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*** Applicants submitting new permanent supportive housing and rapid rehousing project applications should demonstrate coordination with housing providers and healthcare organizations.**

CoC application, priority listing & notification to community	Tuesday, October 15, 2024
HUD deadline via e-snaps	Wednesday, October 30, 2024 (by 8:00 p.m. ET)
