• 2022 Goals: (1) Develop guidelines of best practices for conducting street outreach to vulnerable populations who are experiencing homelessness and/or are at risk of homelessness. Guidelines must consider different needs of individuals experiencing homelessness. (2) Develop guidelines for the County's response to emergency events, situations and unforeseen circumstances that will assist those individuals who have been displaced from their home.

• General Goal(s)/Purpose of this committee: (1)Develop strategies to identify and serve vulnerable populations that might include veterans, homeless youth, DV victims and LGBTQ community amongst others. (2) Explore funding opportunities for these populations. (3) Identify gaps in services for these populations, evaluate needs, provide recommendations to improve services. (4) Develop awareness of issues related to homeless veterans, homeless youth, homeless LGBT community, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, human trafficking and those attempting to flee.
